- Strong understanding of gymnastics fundamentals, terminology, skill progressions, and safe spotting techniques
- Ability to safely lift, assist, and spot students in assigned classes, including athletes weighing up to 130 lbs.
- Energetic, enthusiastic, and positive demeanor
- Ability to capture and maintain children's interest and engagement throughout class
- Ability to “think on your feet,” adapt instruction as needed, and maintain effective class control
- Excellent verbal and interpersonal communication skills with students, parents, coworkers, and supervisors
- Responsible, dependable, and committed to being a positive role model for youth
- Ability to work independently while also functioning effectively as part of a coaching team

- Create a fun, energetic, positive, and safe learning environment for students in every class
- Understand and effectively implement IEGA's Recreational Gymnastics Progressions & Curriculum and teach the skills required for each level
